### **Called Business Meeting**

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As your Church Chairman it is my responsibility and pleasure to announce that a Called Business meeting will be held on Sunday, April 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p. m. As a result of this important meeting, there will be no Sunday night service.

The purpose of this meeting is to explain, in detail, a Facility Expansion program being proposed that will provide much needed space for our existing Fellowship Center to the south and add a connected building on the north of our facility designed to provide additional classroom areas.

This Facility Expansion has become necessary due to a recognized and welcomed growth in our congregation and to allow us the opportunity to increase our ability in “Leading people into an ever-deepening relationship with Jesus Christ” as is our stated Mission.

As required by our Constitution and By-Laws, this project and the associated costs must be approved by the current membership of our church. Therefore, a vote of the membership will be taken at the meeting to provide the Church’s leadership with the authority to move forward with the project.

All members of the Evangelical Free Church of Green Valley are eligible to vote on the project, and we urge you to attend the meeting to become informed of the project details and exercise your vote. If you will be unable to attend the meeting on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April, absentee ballots may be obtained from the Church office Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 3:30 pm. For your vote to count, absentee ballots must be received in the Church office no later than 3:30 pm on April 26<sup>th</sup>; the Friday immediately before the meeting.

Everyone in the congregation is certainly invited to attend this meeting in order to be informed of the project and activities involved, but only members will be allowed to vote.

Please plan to attend this Called Business Meeting to assure your participation in this extremely important decision which will affect our Church’s future and functions.
