

## *Ministry 101*

Mark 6:1-12

Ten principles to remember as you serve Jesus:

1. God may call you to “\_\_\_\_\_” (6:1, 2).
2. You may experience difficult, if not \_\_\_\_\_, ministry (6:2).
3. The people you grew up with may not \_\_\_\_\_ you or God’s purposes for you (6:3, 4).
4. An amazing lack of \_\_\_\_\_, in people to whom you minister, may limit your ministry \_\_\_\_\_ (6:5, 6).

8. Ministry demands treating rich and poor alike, without playing people for \_\_\_\_\_ (6:10).
9. Because ministry leads to a mixed response, God may call you to \_\_\_\_\_ away from those who reject Jesus (6:11).
10. In any ministry, never forget to \_\_\_\_\_ repentance and the good news.
