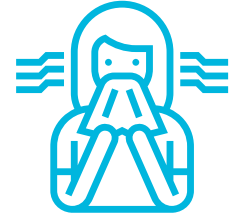


PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7 AMP

PRAY FOR THOSE DIRECTLY AFFECTED BY THE ILLNESS:
